I wanted to give you a quick summary of what was discussed at our recent safety meeting led by Jason Hensley, Director of Safety for Shadow Mountain Ministries:

- We now have consistent protocol to follow in the event of emergencies at every campus, every ministry, every age level
- Protocol is listed on our emergency posters throughout the campus and are designed to be easy to follow by students and staff in the event of an emergency
- Please see our safety poster attached
- Our school participates in monthly emergency drills and we practice many different emergency scenarios
- In the event of an emergency, parents will be notified via RenWeb email as soon as possible
- Parents are reminded that in the middle of the emergency, the focus is on keeping the students safe and cared for; so notifications will not go home until after it is certain that the students are safe and secure
- Safety measures also include name badges for all staff, emergency backpacks in every room, walkie-talkies for communication, and emergency supplies on campus for all students and staff
- We continue to work on improvements in our safety plan, and this will include ensuring that substitute teachers are trained for emergencies

If you have any questions, concerns, or additional thoughts on our safety measures, please feel free to send them to me. Our priority is our children's safety!
