


CHRISTIAN UNIFIED SCHOOLS COMMUNICATIONS

As the majority of communication between school and home is accomplished via email, it is extremely important that we always have a current email address for you in RenWeb. If you need to update personal information, please call the receptionist or secretary at your school, or log into RenWeb and enter your revised information via the "Family Demographics" link.

RenWeb: Individual student information including grades, schedules, classwork, the school directory, current calendars and bulletins can be found by logging into RenWeb. RenWeb is exclusively used by the administration and teachers to send progress reports, report cards and school and class Emails. If you do not receive emails from the school, please double check your email address and make sure that **christianunified.org** is not blocked as spam. Attachments are sent in pdf format, which can be opened in various platforms such as Internet Explorer, Safari, Chrome, Firefox, etc. Please also make sure that you have the most recent version of Adobe Acrobat Reader installed on your computer in order to avoid any issues opening the attachments. To get information about the RenWeb mobile app, log ~~in to~~ into RenWeb and there is an ad on the home page.

Jr/ Sr High students do not automatically have an account created as student email addresses are not generally entered in RenWeb. If they need an account separate from the parent account, they should see Mrs. Alesi in the Counseling Office. Exception: All International students have a RenWeb account set up when they register as they do not live with their parents.

Blackboard: Your student has been provided a login and password which allows them to access the school computer. These credentials also give students access to BlackBoard (from home or school). Several of our teachers use BlackBoard for their classes and will advise students if they should go to BlackBoard to find classwork or information. BlackBoard is also used to access SafeAssignment. Your student should make sure to remember their login and password as they will need these throughout the year. If your student needs password assistance, please direct them to see Mrs. Alesi in the Counseling Office before and after school, and during break and lunch time.

School Website: School information in the areas of academic policies and course content, development, athletics and alumni; access to forms; access to News and Calendars (including News and Notes, the daily bulletin, calendars and the week's athletic activities); employment opportunities; admissions information and applications; and foreign student information can all be found on the school's web site at www.christianunified.org.

News and Notes: News and Notes come out weekly from the elementary school and monthly from the Junior High and High School. The News and Notes newsletter is created by the school principal and sent via email to all parents and students. These newsletters contain valuable information regarding events, policies, awards, and activities happening on your student's campus. They are sent via email on Mondays (elementary) and the first of each month (Jr/Sr High). These newsletters are also posted on the website.

Coaches' Corner: The Athletic Director, David Beezer, during the fall sports season and periodically throughout the rest of the school year, sends an email to the school family regarding athletic events.

Family Connection: Family Connection is the online tool that the High School Counseling Office uses for connecting your student with college planning tools. More information will be provided to both student at parent at various parent nights and scheduled meetings throughout the year. Access to Family Connection is via the school website under the Counseling section as well as via the Student Resources link on the home page. The students' login is generally the same as the student's network login and password.

Counselor Connection: The Counselor Connection is a bi-monthly newsletter produced by the Counseling Center staff for all 9-12th grade students and their parents. The newsletter contains information on SAT and ACT testing dates, college visits, scholarship opportunities, and everything else related to College information. It is sent out via email and posted on the website.
