- Application Fee** – to be submitted with application (new students only) NON-REFUNDABLE \$ 85 KA-8
- Registration Fee** – annual enrollment fee due at the time of registration for the following school year (New and returning students - \$750 max per family) NON-REFUNDABLE \$ 200 K4

- Late Fee** – for payments received after the 1st of the month \$ 50
- Returned Payment Charge** – amount assessed for any returned payment (charged by FACTS) \$ 30
- Payment Plan Fee** – (charged by FACTS) \$ 20-50

Before/After School Care For School Rate Students: The teachers will wait for 15 minutes after pick up. At 3:15 pm, (3:00 p.m. for K4) any children not picked up will be taken to daycare and a \$10.00 per hour fee (or any part of the hour) will be billed. This is only for emergencies; we are not staffed for many extra students

Note Regarding Fundraising: Tuition and fees provide only a portion of the total cost required to educate a student at Christian Unified Schools of San Diego. CUSSD does not participate in student sales activities (ie: candy sales), but does conduct fundraising campaigns (Jog-a-thon, auction, Annual Fund), and asks that each family make contributions to the school as their circumstances allow. In addition to monetary gifts, many parents contribute time and resources to perform tasks that would otherwise result in increased expenses to CUSSD.
