Our Program

Christian High School, founded in 1965 by Tim LaHaye, pioneered private evangelical Christian secondary education in San Diego County. With its tradition of academic, athletic, and artistic excellence CHS created a prototype for Christian schools nationwide. CHS provides a rigorous college-preparatory curriculum for a diverse population of 369 students including a dynamic International Program. Located in San Diego's East County, CHS represents a variety of communities, ranging from modern urban cities to neighboring rural communities.

The International Program was established in 1990 and currently enrolls 71 students from five countries. Our broad curriculum choices sets us apart from other programs. Students live with American homestay families to experience local culture in and out of school. The Cross Culture Club enlists students from domestic and international backgrounds to blend and learn from one another

We are pleased to highlight the following areas for the international community:

- Three day, two night all expenses paid trip each school year especially tailored to the international students. This year will be the LA Experience with Universal Studios, two museums, and UCLA as the destinations.
- Four cultural events planned throughout the year to enhance the American experience for each international student and host family.
- Campus Clubs include the following: Cross Culture, Cooking, Ping Pong, Board Games, and Oceanography.
- Elective classes based on student interest and merit include: STEM, Robotics, Home Economics, Woodshop, Oceanography, American Sign Language, Digital Video, Advanced Film, On Your Own/Personal Finance, Yearbook, Speech, Leadership.
- Excellent Fine Arts program with Drama I and II, Concert Choir, Vocal Ensemble, Jazz Band, Concert Band, Marching Band, and Art I, II, AP Art, and Introduction to Photography classes.
- Optional travel opportunities during summer and spring breaks.

CHS is continually honored throughout the community by earning first place and superior ratings in curricular and co-curricular programs including student publications, academic competitions and fine arts. Over 75% of our student body participates in athletics and eleven of our 19 athletic teams have won California Interscholastic Federation (CIF) championships over the past decade.
