New Child Seat Law.....

California Law Beginning January 1, 2012:

Children ***MUST*** be secured in an appropriate child passenger restraint (safety seat or booster seat) **IN THE BACK SEAT OF A VEHICLE** until they are at least **8 YEARS OLD** or 4' 9" in height. **This will affect Kindergarten, 1st Grade, and 2nd Grade students**
