



HOST FAMILY FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How can I become a host family of an international student at CUSSD?

Become approved by a homestay placement company.

How can I find a host family for my student attending CUSSD?

Ask a homestay placement company to help you.

Can a student live with a blood relative without going through a placement company?

Yes, as long as an Affidavit of Relationship, with required documentation, is provided.

What happens if I want to move?

You can move if your guardian approves the move and informs the school before the move. Your new host family must be arranged by the guardian through the homestay placement company.

Do the teachers, staff and long-term hosts also have to be with a company?

Yes

The Homestay placement company you are registered with

Am I responsible to redo information every time a student changes homes? Is it required?

YES! On all forms, the data on all programs, the Department of Homeland Security requires it
